

Dear Artists,

We have been asked again this year to exhibit our art on the lawn of Nelles Manor 126 Main St W, Grimsby on September 21st. I hope you are all excited about being part of this opportunity to show your work to your friends, neighbours and the community. I am eager to take your submissions anytime before September 7th. Please read the following requirements and suggestions before submitting your work.

Submission Limit

Artists are welcome to submit **ten** pieces of original artwork to go on the racks. Once all the submissions are in if our numbers are too high for the space we have we may ask you to choose one or two paintings to leave out of the show.

How to Enter

Please make your submissions of work that is going on the racks by email. Submissions are being accepted until September 7th.

Artwork Size

Artwork width cannot exceed 90cm (36 in.) framed in order to fit on the racks.

Small Pieces of Art

You may submit an unlimited number of small pieces of art on paper (drawings, watercolour, pastel) that are on a backing board, matted, and in a clear plastic bag. (maximum size – 11x14 including matt) Check here for samples <https://clearbags.ca> Cards are also accepted. All items must be clearly labelled with your name and the price of the item. Please email me by September 7th with your name, phone number and the number of items you are submitting. (edfrlw@gmail.com) Please put the word “Exhibition” in the subject box of the email.

Volunteers

In order to make this exhibition a success we rely on our members to volunteer. If you are submitting work you are encouraged to volunteer if you are able. I will contact you with a list of volunteer opportunities at a later date.

Artwork Labels

Securely affix a label onto the back of each painting with the:

Title

Name of the Artist

Medium

Price

Drop off and Pick up

Please drop your paintings off between 10:00 and 10:30 and pick them up at 3:00. Please note those times on your calendar. We cannot accept work at other times, and we insist that you pick-up your work at the scheduled time.

At the time of drop-off, to help us with overhead costs, we are asking a ten dollar cash payment per artist who submits work. At that time you will be required to sign your name indicating that you understand that the **Lakeshore Pumphouse Artists Association or the executive is not responsible for theft or damages to your painting. Each exhibitor is responsible for insuring their own work.**

When you drop-off your artwork with us, it needs to be “Gallery Ready”. We want our exhibits of your artwork to look professional, and we need to be able to install your work easily. Please ensure that you have a strong-enough braided picture hanging wire securely attached to the back of the work. The wire should have enough slack that it is easy for us to use a hand behind the work to guide it onto the rack. However, the top of the wire when pulled up should be at least 4 cm or 1.5 inches from the top of the frame so that the hanging hardware is not visible when your work is on the wall.

We have some amazing artists in our group. It is always exciting to see samples of all of our work in one place. Grimsby here we come!
