

Atanur Dogan Supplies List 2025

Watercolour Canvas — Please bring watercolour canvas: 9x10 or 12x14, available from DeSerres.

Watercolour paints — Most watercolour paints come in small tubes. Inexpensive Cotman paints are just fine, but if you don't mind spending more money, you can get artist quality paints, which provide richer pigments and better transparency. Consider paints such as Holbein or Winsor & Newton.

Watercolour palette — Palettes are made of formed white plastic, one with 16 wells would be ideal.

Watercolour brushes — Make sure that you have a least one in small, medium and large sizes round brushes. Three or four pointed brushes or varying sizes are all you need; a #26 or #30, a #8, a #6 and a #2 or #3. You can choose either soft natural bristles or slightly bouncier nylon bristles. Natural bristles give better flow and nylon gives more control.

Paper support — This is the support for taping the watercolour paper. For example, Plexiglas, plywood, cardboard, etc. Use whatever method you are comfortable with to mount or stretch your paper.

Miscellaneous —

- Two water containers, like yogurt cups, or margarine containers,
- Paper towels, or rags,
- Sketchbook, or a few sheets of drawing paper,
- Bring a photograph of something you would like to paint.

It is not necessary to go out and buy more supplies for this workshop. Your usual palette, brushes and paints will work just fine.
