

Cheryl Goldring Waterfall Class – Acrylic

Materials list

- 20 x 30" canvas - Gallery size (1 1/2) inch depth - preainted in black gesso or wait to do it at the lesson. Either way is fine. I know we all lead busy lives.
- 2" and 3" paintbrush. Paint store grade is fine
- HB pencil and eraser, one white chalk, ruler/palette/dish for water (I will bring some
- as well)
- Other brushes: 1 round, 1 pointed round, 1 angular, 1 wash, 1 flat and any combination you would normally use.
- This painting uses a lot of broad strokes. The fine work is limited to pops of subdued colour, and outlining and painting of rocks, and water details
- The colour palette is simple but feel free to change it up. You are the artist.
 - Paynes grey, Vandyke Brown, Titanium white, carbon black, bone black (any black will do) Prussian blue, yellow ochre, Titan buff, cerulean blue, transparent red iron, oxide Jenkins green, light green, cad red, cad yellow
 - Bring a large clean rag cloth. You may need it to blend colours
 - I will have all these colours and more so don't worry if you forget one or two
- Water is the star and everything else plays a supporting role
- I will bring a painting in progress and will be illustrating the step
